Easy to spot feather flags and A2 Studio numbered signs will be placed outside each studio, so keep an eye out as you tour from studio to studio for the flag flying and the sign with the studio number. You will then know you have arrived!

All studios and artists will be open from the core hours of 10am to 4pm on Sat & Sun 14/15 & 21/22 October.

Some studios will also be open some days during the week between or by appointment as indicated on the artists leger. Please be sure to check each artists individual listing to ensure they may be there when you hope to visit.
